- At present I am the Operations Manager with GOSHH, a community and voluntary organisation based in Limerick City. I have been a staff member with GOSHH for almost 8 years and prior to that I was a volunteer with the organisation. I work with an organisation that actively challenges inequality and stigma on a daily basis.
- I have been involved in the Community & Voluntary sector for the last 15 years. I have been involved in a number of different Community & Voluntary groups including Limerick LGBTQ Pride Festival, Blue Box Creative Arts Centre and Clare Youth Service and I am currently a board member of PAUL Partnership, Limerick. I was also a member of the local coordination group for Yes Equality Limerick during the 2015 Marriage Referendum. I was part of the team that launched the bid for Limerick to host the 2018 Gay Games. Limerick made it to the final three cities eventually losing out to Paris but I stayed involved with the International Federation of Gay Games and held the role of Officer of International Membership for 2 years.
- I previously represented Limerick PPN as a member of the Community, Leisure & Emergency Services Strategic Planning Committee.
- This is an exciting time to be part of this new venture for Limerick representing Limerick PPN on the Implementation Advisory Group on the Directly Elected Mayor to ensure the needs and the interests of our members are heard and to do so in an independent and professional manner.
