The concept of Sustainable Development began to gather momentum following the 1987 Brundtland Report, Our Common Future.

The Earth Summit (UN Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED) in 1992 introduced the need for the integration of economic development, environmental protection, and social justice and inclusion. Agenda 21, which was a voluntary SD plan of action, for implementation by national, regional and local governments.





# SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

2000 – Millennium Summit in New York, which resulted in the Millennium Development Goals

**2012** – Rio+20, which resulted in an outcome document, The Future We Want, in which States reaffirmed commitments to all previous SD agreements, plans and targets. They also **committed to develop the Sustainable Development Goals** (SDGs)

**2015** - more than 190 world leaders commit to the **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** to help us all end extreme poverty, fight inequality & injustice, and fix climate change.











































#### The SDG doughnut
