Overview of the Chief Executive's report on the re-draft public consultation stage for the proposed Limerick Development Plan 2022 – 2028	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The CE's report covered the outcomes from the initial Public Consultation stage on the new Development Plan for adoption by 2022. • It was noted that Climate Change Action was one of the strongest themes to emerge from the feedback. • Councillors expressed concern at the criteria for one off houses but officials stated that LCCC was bound by National Policy Framework guidelines with which Dev Plan must comply. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LCCC will explore option of workshop/briefing session on Development Plan for PPN which will allow more detailed discussions around it. • LCCC will be organising a workshop on Protected Structures for elected members, and can do this for the PPN also. • The next meeting will address issues raised around Derelict Sites. • Renewable Energy and Climate Change related Action will be a priority for LCCC in the Plan on foot of feedback. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brian T asked if workshop/briefing session on development plan could be given to the Linkage Group before next stage is closed.
