<b>1 Review of 2030 Plan</b>	KPMG presented on their review of 2030 plan. This is high-level strategy for the city, and identifies some issues and opportunities. Early consultations showed (among others) that city lacks identity & vision, not living up to potential, weak retail, that LK has strong sectoral clusters, education should be an enabler. Emerging concepts are to build on what's good, use riverside more, use existing buildings rather than new build, and develop more cultural/public space.	No significant action, review is continuing	ML asked about public realm tender just issued, was told it was physical infra rather than high-level strategy, and it would probably follow the review's recommendations, given timelines.  BT asked how size of LK is factored into plans, as comparing larger cities example not always appropriate. Was told specific successful programmes from larger cities are being cited, but these are scalable to LK's size.
<b>2. LEO presentation on SME Task Force</b>	LEO gave presentation on its work & activity in Limerick (different grants etc). Working now on: Digital collaboration centre, Happen Midwest Co-Working Spaces, Film Mid West. Hubs for Abbeyfeale & Rathkeale, and now working on other spaces including Engine in Lk city. Trying to CPO Cecil St buildings for new digital centre.	A suggested template for SME Task Force to be sent to Full Council Meeting in April. Rec is for 2 members from EDEP SPC, 2 business community, Mayor, 1 education/training sector. A joint reporting (to EDEP SPC and LEO) is suggested.	DH says East Lk not getting supports needed, LCCC reply they're engaging with banks to repurpose buildings & more hubs will be announced. Says they'll update in coming months.
