

Home & Social Development Linkage Group Meeting Outcomes

Zoom Online June 16th 2021

- One of the main issues discussed was the need to continue to engage with and educate
 council tenants on energy effiencey schmes and home retrofit measures. We need to see
 the training programme and it needs to be a plain language document as there are
 increasing calls for further engagement due to increasing energy bills and a perception that
 there is no gain from these energy efficiences. Reports of tenants turning heating off to
 keep cots down and being unsure of how to use it.
- A discussion was had around the Dev Plan and the green zoning of Pineview Gardens and the Moyross Partners call for Pineview to be rezoned back to residential as 71 families (205 individuals) continue to reside in houses in Pineview Gardens or 10% of the population of Moyross. PPN to consider writing to Vincent Murray / Seamus Hanrahan about this issue.
- Disucssion was had around mixed tenure housing and ongoing need for delivery of social and afforable housing in the city. 100 new homes planned for Moyross since 2014, which have yet to be delivered.
- Ongoing frustrations with HAP.
